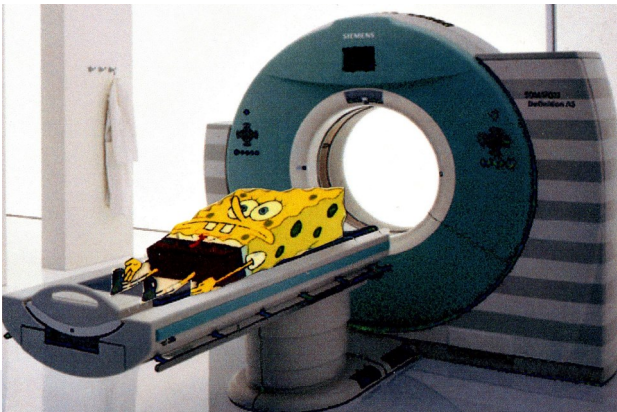
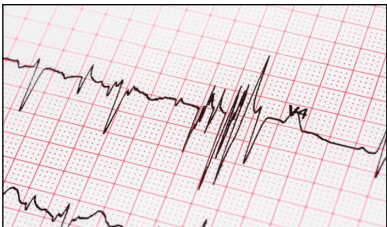
Every reunion party is fun and special. But in recent years, attendance has dipped a bit, as people leave the area for other parts of the country—or for other dimensions.

This makes Rusty sad. He's very sensitive, you know. And when Rusty gets sad, he drinks. W-a-y too much.

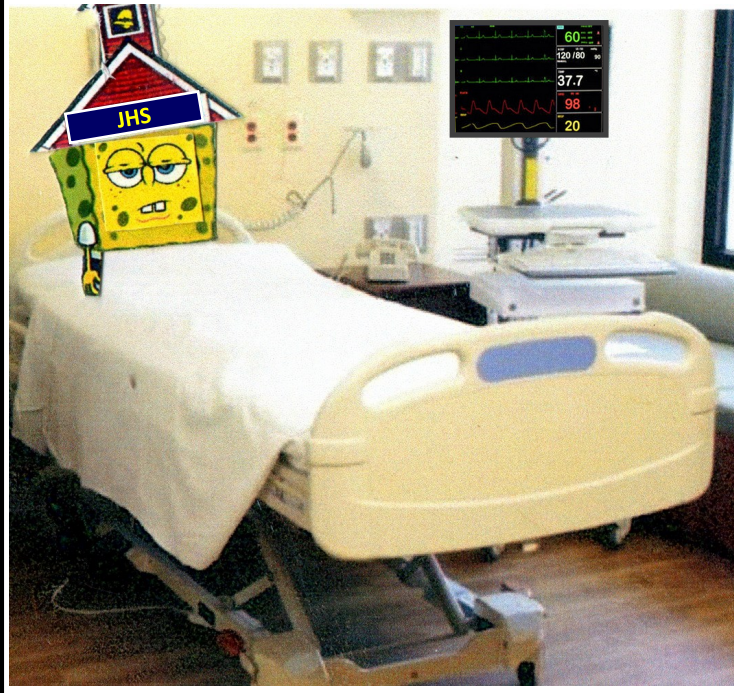

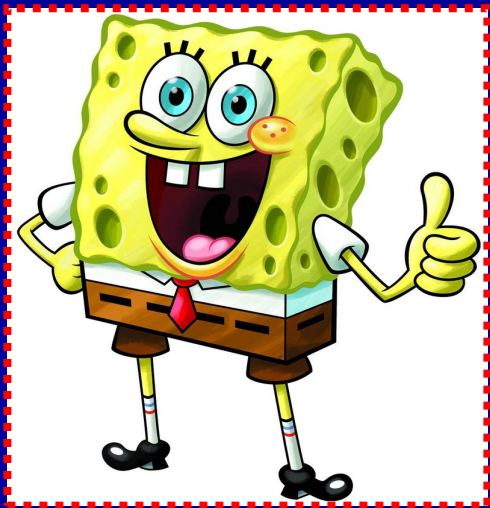

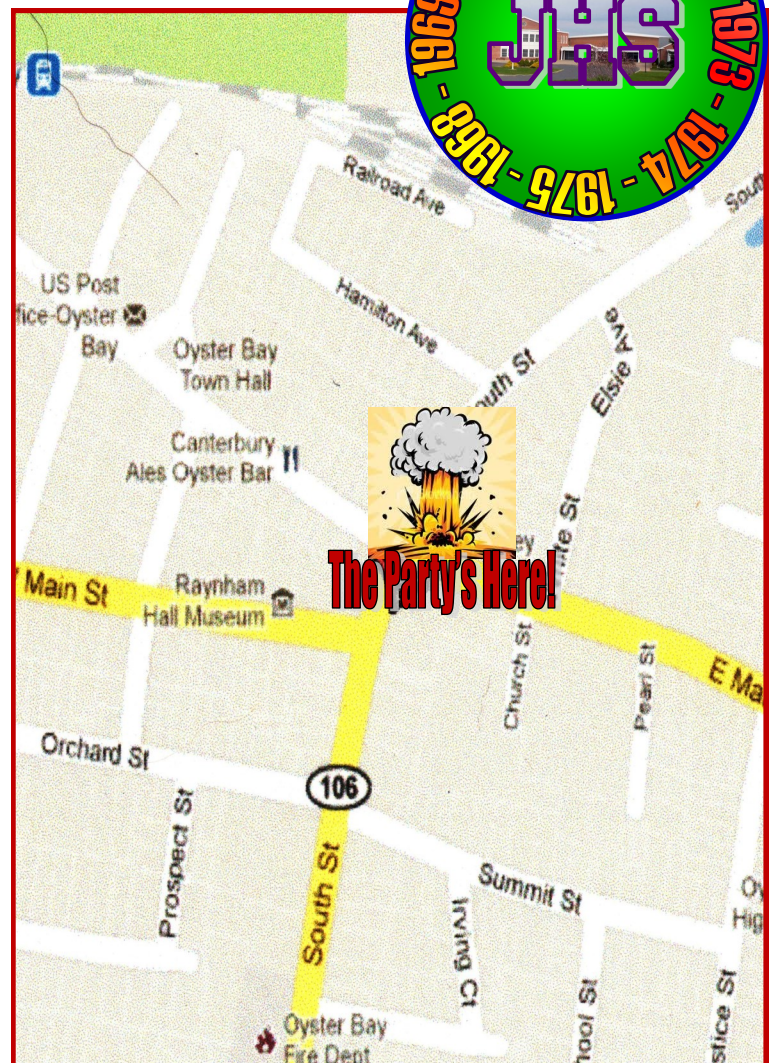

Directions to the Homestead (107 South Street, Oyster Bay, LI)

From the Long Island Expressway or
 Northern State Parkway

1. Travel north on Route 106-107 (North Broadway).
2. Just past the Milleridge Inn, bear right onto Route 106, which takes you past the side entrance to Jericho High School. Feel free to salute, genuflect, or flip the bird—however the spirit moves you.
3. Continue past Northern Boulevard (Route 25A) and into the town of Oyster Bay.
4. Route 106 becomes South Street. The Homestead is at the corner of South Street and East Main Street.
5. Make a right-hand turn onto E. Main Street and then a right-hand turn on Church Street into the municipal parking lot behind the Homestead.
6. The front entrance is on South Street; the back entrance is through the courtyard from the parking lot.

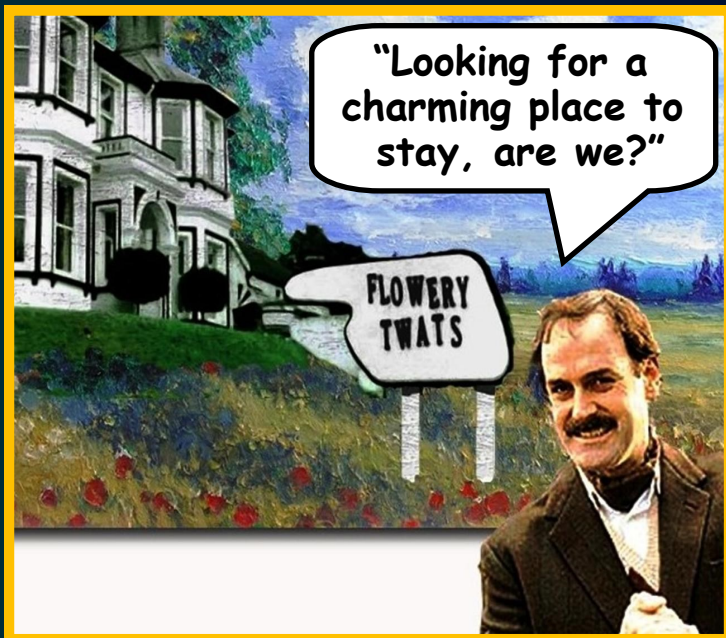
